ervation of ancient structures and heritage sites. For example, many ancient structures contain  $inscriptions\, and\, texts\, written$ in languages that are no longer spoken. Without the knowledge of these languages, it becomes challenging to understand the significance of

these structures and their place in history. When a language dies, it takes with it the understanding of the culture and history that it represents. This loss is significant for indigenous cultures

whose languages are often closely tied to their land, customs, and beliefs. Preserving languages is also crucial for promotion of linguistic diversity. It is time we take this issue seri-

ously and work towards preserving the

world's endangered languages to ensure

that these languages continue to thrive
